







// DEMONSTRATION TEAM

DEMONSTRATION TEAMS WILL PRESENT A CHOREOGRAPHED PERFORMANCE OF NO LONGER THAN 7 MINUTES THAT SHOULD INCLUDE A VARIETY OF ADVANCED TECHNIQUES.

Demonstration Teams with a minimum of 10 members and maximum of 50 members with all members making a meaningful contribution during the team's performance.

Each team member must participate in at least one additional individual OTC competitive event.

Set Up: 2 Minutes

Performance: 7 Minutes (Start: Team's first bow | End: Team's final bow)

> Note: A half-point will be deducted from overall score for every 10 seconds a performance exceeds the 7 minute time limit.

Clean Up: 2 Minutes

// TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

Creative Form (Full Team)

Board Breaking

> Wooden boards (Team or OTC provided) are the only valid breaking material and must be inspected prior to performance.

> All breaks must be the doing of the breaker. Holders may not cause or aid in the breaking of the boards.

Self-Defense

Equal, meaningful participation of all team members

// INCLUSIONS

Permitted

- > Props, costumes, and equipment
- > Imitation weapons with no live blades
- > Concrete and bricks, but may not be used as breaking material
- > Flowers and confetti, but must be cleaned up within allotted time

Prohibited

- Glitter
- > Live bladed weapons > Liquids of any kind
- Food of any kind

Masters, coaches, and instructors may assist with music during the performance.

Coaching/instruction may be given by a team member during the performance.

> Note: Coaching/instruction may not be provided by anyone who is not on the team.

Judging will be based upon the following criteria:

> Team spirit

Difficulty and execution of techniques

> Teamwork

- Originality
- > Adherence to technical requirements > Adherence to time allotments

OPEN POOMSAE

COMPETITORS WILL DEMONSTRATE A FORM OF THEIR CHOOSING.

ELIGIBILITY

Tiny, Intermediate and Black Belts are eligible to compete

RULES

// FORMAT

Single elimination

// REQUIREMENTS

Competitors may demonstrate a form of their choosing

Participants will compete simultaneously with those they are grouped with by OTC staff.

// SCORING

Judging will be based upon competitor's ddemonstration of the following criteria while completing their selected form:

- Balance
- Rhythm
- Manner

// BOARD BREAKING

COMPETITORS WILL DEMONSTRATE HAND AND FOOT BREAKING TECHNIQUES THAT WILL BE DEPENDENT UPON BELT RANK (AS LISTED BELOW).

ELIGIBILITY

Tiny, Intermediate and Black Belts are eligible to compete.

RULES

// SET UP

Single elimination

// TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

TINY DIVISION - 2 BOARDS

> Any 1 Hand Technique + Any 1 Kick

INTERMEDIATE DIVISION - 3 BOARDS

> Any 1 Hand + Any 1 Kick + Any 1 Kick

BLACK BELT DIVISION - UNLIMITED BOARDS

- > Any 1 Hand + Any 1 Kick + Freestyle
- Note: Black Belt competitors may use power breaking for any of their techniques. Any move may be a combination break, such as a double or triple kick, but breaks must be completed simultaneously or while in the air to count as one break.

Prohibited

- >Props
- >Head breaks (OTC-provided boards are required and may be purchased during registration or on-site for \$3 each)

// SCORING

Judging will use a 10-point scoring system based upon:

- Technique Rhythm Manner
- Balance Kihap

EVENT REGULATIONS

// OLYMPIC STYLE CONTACT SPARRING

COMPETITORS WILL BE MATCHED TO SPAR BASED ON: GENDER, BELT RANK, AGE, HEIGHT, AND WEIGHT.

ELIGIBILITY

Intermediate and Black Belt divisions are eligible to compete.

RULES

// FORMAT

Random seeding

Single elimination

// ROUNDS & TIMING

Intermediate Division (Color Belts) - 2 Rounds

- > Round Duration: 45 Seconds
- > Break Duration: 20 Seconds

Black Belt Division - 2 Rounds

- > Round Duration: 1 Minute
- Break Duration: 30 Seconds

// REQUIRED SAFETY GEAR

All competitors must wear WT-style

- Chest guard
- Arm guards
- Hand guardsShin guards
- Instep guards
- Mouth guardsInstep guards

Required only for males:

• Groin guard

Protective gear must align with World Taekwondo style standards. No other protective gear will be accepted. All protective gear must be worn for the duration of the event. Competitors presenting to the ring without full protective gear will be disqualified.

// SCORING

All divisions:

- Valid punch on chest guard: 1 Point
- Valid roundhouse kick on chest guard: 2 Points
- Valid spinning kick on chest guard: 3 Points
- Valid side kick on chest guard: 2 Points

// GAM-JEOM PENALTIES (FULL POINT PENALTIES)

The Referee shall declare penalties on any prohibited acts. Prohibited acts shall be penalized with Gam-jeom (deduction penalty)

A gam-jeom shall be counted as a one point penalty which will be recorded by adding one point to the opponent's score. All gam-jeoms are counted in the grand total.

Gam-jeom will be declared for any of the following prohibited acts regardless of division of the competitor:

- Head shots of any kind
- > Two-handed punches
- Butting or attacking with the knee
- Kicking below the waistUse of excessive force
- Lifting the leg to block

- Crossing boundary line with one foot touching mat
 Falling down
- Falling down
- Avoiding or delaying the matchContinuing attack following kal-yeo
- Attacking a fallen opponent
- > Grabbing or holding the opponent
